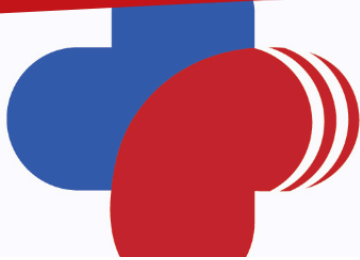

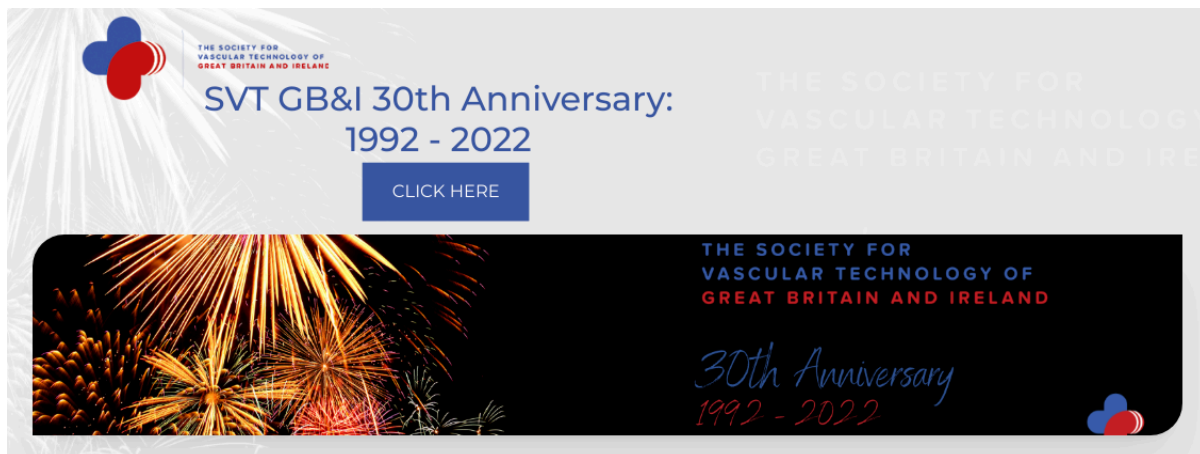

Healthcare Science (Vascular Science) BSc (Hons) Update

The Science (Vascular Science) BSc (Hons) is now visible on the [Gloucestershire University website](#) and [UCAS website](#).

With full support of the NSHCS we will be aiming for AHCS and CASE accreditation to ensure graduates get automatic registration with the [AHCS practitioner register](#).

The SVT are now working with the University to produce the curriculum content for the degree which realises the discussions held in previous SVT Heads of Service meetings. This information will be added to the course detail over the coming months.

This new Vascular Practitioner training will standardise the learning and training expected at this level, this is particularly important now that some centres have already developed this role locally to help resolve workforce issues. This new qualification will also help increase the workforce nationally.

The course will run as both a distance learning apprenticeship and direct entry degree with the aim of opening for the first intake in Sept 2023.
